The Terms of Reference were handed down to the ALRC by the then Attorney-General R.J Ellicott on February 9, 1977 (See Part ii: Field Trip Reports, FT1 page xiii for Terms of Reference). After extensive community consultation, consideration of submissions and public hearings (transcripts of which can be found at S34/7 in the AIATSIS Library) the Final Report and Recommendations were tabled in 1985.

Throughout the Reference the ALRC produced Research and Discussion Papers on various aspects of Aboriginal Customary Law. Many Submissions were made in response to these Papers and familiarity with them is necessary to understanding the Submissions.
