Production history

These recordings were collected between 1 June 1954 and 27 August 1965 by Murray J. Barrett during fieldwork in and around Yuendumu in the Northern Territory. The purpose of the recordings was to gather information on the cultures of the Warlpiri and Pintupi peoples of Central Australia. Within this collection is information on the customs, languages, music, material culture, ceremonies and history of the Warlpiri and Pintupi.
