### Production history

This collection was recorded on 16 July 2010 by Lyndon Ormond-Parker during field work at Port Keats / Wadeye in the Northern Territory of Australia. They document Mark Crocombe's memories and thoughts on Wadeye, an Indigenous settlement in the Northern Territory. Topics include his going to Wadeye, the history of the settlement, outstations, bush food, preservation of culture, endangered languages, the Kanamkek-Yile Ngala Museum, the Wadeye Knowledge Centre, education and events. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 16 July 2010.
