WE ARE EXCITED TO ANNOUNCE THE 2025 AIATSIS SUMMIT WILL BE CO-HOSTED IN PARTNERSHIP WITH LARRAKIA NATION ABORIGINAL CORPORATION IN GARRAMILLA (DARWIN).

The AIATSIS Summit 2025 (the Summit) offers a unique opportunity for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elders, leaders, and youth along with Academics, Native Title stakeholders, legal experts, GLAM (Galleries, Libraries, Archives and Museums) sector and government representatives to come together and collaborate on the issues that matter most to First Nations peoples.

As one of the largest Australian conferences of its kind and winner of the 2024 Australian Event of the Year, the AIATSIS Summit offers opportunities to support and strengthen Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures, knowledge, and governance.

In 2025, the Summit will incorporate a three-day Indigenous Country and Governance component (4-6 June), Mabo Lecture (3 June), and dedicated PBC day (4 June). Youth focussed sessions will be delivered across all five days. A wide range of exhibitors will be featured throughout the Summit 2025 accompanied by an engaging social and cultural program culminating in a Gala dinner on Friday 6 June.

The Larrakia Nation has grown strong in recent years and delivers a wide range of programs and services across the Darwin region. The Larrakia Nation's vision is Larrakia First: Larrakia working together as the cultural authority to lead, connect and protect.

Established in 1997 through the Northern Land Council, Larrakia Nation has a proud history of representing the Traditional Owners of the Darwin region extending from Gunn Point in the north, Manton Dam in the south, Adelaide River in the east and the Cox Peninsula in the west.

For over 20 years, LNAC has grown to represent the Traditional Owners of the Darwin region and speak on behalf of Larrakia people while delivering community and outreach services to the broader Darwin community.


