BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Roger Cribb was an Australian archaeologist, anthropologist and applied social scientist.

He conducted ethno-archaeological research of nomads in the Middle East from approximately 1979 to 1981, which resulted in the publication of *Nomads in Archaeology* (See AIATSIS Library, B C928.07/N1).

In 1982, Roger Cribb and his family returned to Australia. His research in Australia focussed on the West Cape York area, particularly around Aurukun and Weipa. He studied the shell mounds and paid special attention to the Indigenous people and the development of the

area. He formed close relationships with Indigenous people and assisted them in many aspects of their lives, such as health, land rights and economic issues. Roger Cribb developed the genealogical software 'Gentree' to help communities record their genealogies. He also used computer simulation to analyse the data collected in his fieldwork, which makes him a pioneer of using a Geographic Information System (GIS) and genealogical software in archaeological and anthropological research.

COLLECTION OVERVIEW

Scope and contents note

The collection is comprised of field notes, discussion papers and articles, consultation reports, photographs, and reference materials. It was created by Roger Cribb in approximately 1970 to 2007 based on his ethno-archaeological fieldwork in Anatolia, Europe, and Cape York Peninsula, Australia. His research includes information about nomads in Anatolia and Australia, archaeological sites and a computer simulation system for genealogical and geographical data. In 2008, the collection was donated by Roger Cribb's ex-wife Gulcin Cribb. The material describes the geography, the environment and his life in the field and it contributes to understanding Roger Cribb's research contents, process and methods. The collection is divided into three series according to the subjects: (1) Early research in Turkey, (2) Research in Australia, and (3) Computer Simulation.

Provenance

The collection was donated by Roger Cribb's ex-wife Gulcin Cribb on 16 January 2008 after Cribb's death in 2007.

Material separated from the collection

The negatives, originally deposited with the photographs, are in the Pictorial collection because that provides a better preservation environment for them. They have the photographic call number CRIBB.R01.CN; however, the related manuscript (MS) numbers have been retained in the photographic captions for cross-referencing.

'Aak: Aboriginal estates and clans between the Embley and Edward Rivers Cape York Peninsula' by Peter Sutton, David Martin, John von Sturmer, Roger Cribb, and Athol Chase, was deposited with this material in 2008; however it was added to MS 2878 as copy 3.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

The series are arranged according to Roger Cribb's research, which includes early research in Anatolia (Turkey), research in Australia, and using computer simulation as a research method to analyse the data collected in the field.

Series 1 Early research in Turkey

From the 1970s to early 1980s, Roger Cribb did his early fieldwork amongst the nomadic pastoralists in Turkey and surrounding regions. In this series, hand-drawn tent sites, photographs and transparencies reflect his research and analysis of nomads.
