The collection consists of mostly published materials or grey literature relating to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children's and adult education compiled over three decades by Aboriginal educator John Raymond Budby. The materials consist of: seminar

papers; reports published by universities, Commonwealth, and State Government bodies; correspondence regarding educational programmes; pamphlets.

## **Provenance**

The material was donated to University of Southern Queensland (USQ) College of Indigenous Studies, Education and Research (CISER) by Mr John Budby for educational purposes. Correspondence associated with this collection dating from 2013 and 2014 indicates that John Budby's widow, Vera Budby, entrusted CISER with lodging an offer of donation of the materials to AIATSIS in order that anyone studying Aboriginal and Torres Strait education could have access to his collection. The material was donated to AIATSIS by USQ in 2022.

## **Biographical history note**

John Budby was born in Queensland and after gaining a secondary teaching qualification from the Australian School of Pacific Administration, he taught in Papua New Guinea. He returned to Australia in 1975, teaching at Emerald High School in Central Queensland, before his appointment as advisory teacher to the Queensland Department of Education the following year. In June 1976, Budby became an education officer of the Queensland Department on Aboriginal education and was appointed a member of the National Aboriginal Education Committee in 1977, becoming Chairman of the organisation in 1980. From 2000 to 2003 Budby worked for the University of Southern Queensland and remained involved in Aboriginal Education until his death in 2007.
