Collection Overview

Scope and Contents note

The collection comprises 76 field diaries written by anthropologist Jeremy Beckett while conducting extended periods of fieldwork in Western New South Wales and the Torres Strait Islands over a period of 50 years from 1958-2008. The diary entries include observations of culture, language, kinship, and community understanding of and attitudes to New South Wales and Queensland administrative authorities. The collection also includes transcriptions of selected diaries.

This collection contains both physical and digital material.

This collection was donated to AIATSIS by Sophia Beckett and Simeon Beckett, executors of the estate of Jeremy Beckett, on the 1 November 2023.

Biographical note

Professor Jeremy Beckett was born in 1931. He taught anthropology at the University of Sydney, was a Visiting Professor at the City University of New York Graduate Center, the Australian National University, New York University, and the University of Texas at Austin. Beckett carried out long term field research with Australian Aboriginal people, specifically on Barkindji country in Western New South Wales, and the Torres Strait Islands, and his research contributed to the Murray Island Land Case ('Mabo'), and the 2009 Torres Strait Sea Rights case where he was an Expert Witness. He passed away in December 2022.

Archivists note

The diaries are largely written in pencil, and some have faded with time. Some diary covers missing and/or bindings broken.

The item titles (eg. NSW 1, TSI 2) and descriptions in this Finding Aid were compiled from descriptions written by Lucie Downer under the supervision of Jeremy Beckett. Some words have been changed at the discretion of the archivist, eg. Lucie Downer referred to Jeremy Beckett as Jeremy – these instances have been changed to Beckett in this finding aid.

The spelling of the languages in the description are Beckett's original spelling. Square brackets "[]" enclose the preferred term in the AIATSIS AUSTLANG database. For example, Paakantji [Paakantyi/Paakantji/Barkindji, D12] and Ngiyambaa [Ngiyampaa/Ngempa, D22].

Series Description Series 1, Western New South Wales field diaries. 1957-1992.

Series 1 comprises field diaries compiled by Jeremy Beckett whilst visiting North Western New South Wales, including: Paakantyi/Barkindji country (Wilcannia), Murrin Bridge, Mount Manara/Hillston, Broken Hill, Bulla Downs, Tibooburra. This notebook was written during Beckett's first fieldwork trip to Western NSW. It includes Paakantji [Paakantyi/Paakantji/Barkindji, D12] language translations as well as notes from his conversation with George Dutton. George Dutton told the myths of "The Kangaroo and the Euro" and "The Two Ngatyi " which relate to Pantyikali/ Wanyiwalku country. This notebook informs Beckett's 2003 book 'Mutawintji : Aboriginal Cultural Association with Mutawintji National Park' co-written by Luise Hercus, Sarah Martin and edited by Claire Colyer.

This is Beckett's 1957 fieldwork diary written during his first fieldwork trip to Murrin Bridge and Lake Cargelligo. He writes of his daily activities, interactions and interviews with people living there at the time. The notebook also has information about Beckett's correspondence with his supervisor Anthropologist WEH Stanner regarding his research.
