They include language elicitation: vocabulary, word lists, sentences, kinship terms, place names and song words. The language material was collected from the following areas in Western Australia: Pilbara area (WA SF50, SF51, SG50), Gascoyne / Murchison area (WA SG50), Carnarvon (WA South Pilbara / Gascoyne SG49-04)
