These recordings feature oral history interviews with Iris Russell conducted by Tim Hill and Graeme Russell at Port Stephens, NSW, in November and December 2005. They were created as part of a cultural heritage assessment of Soldiers Point by Tim Hill Heritage Management and Planning for the Department of Environment and Conservation (NSW). Mrs Russell, a Worimi elder, discusses Soldiers Point Village, Bagnalls Beach Aboriginal Reserve, and the Ridgeway family of Karuah and Nelsons Bay. Les Russell and Elaine Larkin also contribute to the second recording session.
