These songs are part of a public section of the ceremony and were recorded in the public area of the outstation. They sound very similar to secret songs from other ceremonies, and it would be easy for those without the necessary knowledge to assume incorrectly that they are non-public songs associated with other regional restricted cult ceremonies such as the Kunabibi.

Restrictions on use

This collection is restricted and may only be copied by relevant Indigenous individuals, community people, funding body, bona fide academic researchers, regional cultural centres and language centres and those who have obtained permission from Bawinanga Aboriginal Corporation.

Speakers and performers include Djambunuwa, David Milaybuma, Bill Birriyabirriya, Jimmy Njiminjuma, John Dalngadalnga, Jimmy Djarrbbarali, Charlie ('Shotgun') Namurludda, and James Iyuna.
