Production history

These recordings were collected by the Irra Wangga – Geraldton Language Programme on 2-3 August and 12 September 2007 at the Olive Laird Hostel, Carnarvon, Western Australia. They feature elicitation of the Warriyangka language with Mavis Chubby, including words and expressions generated by random, situational dialogue and occasional dictionary questions. According to Irra Wangga, Mrs Chubby is one of the last surviving Warriyangka speakers. She is the daughter of Alec Eagle who provided information on the language to Peter Austin toward the publication of *A dictionary of Warriyangga, Western Australia* (1992). The recordings in this collection were made by linguist Adriano Truscott and language worker Leanne Kelly, occasionally using words from Austin's dictionary.
