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COLLECTION OVERVIEW

Scope and content note

This collection comprises the creative work of some of the pupils at the Aurukun Mission School. The documents are stories, compositions and drawings. Writing paper, exercise books and special drawing books were generally the materials used, but brown paper, the back of greeting cards, envelopes and pieces of cardboard were also used.

The work was done using pencils, colouring pencils, crayon and occasionally paint.

The collection was deposited in the AIATSIS Library by John von Sturmer in February 1982.

Archivist's note

Items in this collection are organized into four series – Compositions, Pictures, New books, Illustrated prayers and stories. They are numbered according to the box in which they were initially housed; this numbering sometimes still accords with the box in which it is now housed. Sometimes however it no longer does. For example, item 134 in Series 1 Compositions is numbered MS 1620/2/134 and is still found in box 2; but item 188 in Series 2 Pictures is numbered MS 1620/3/188 but is now housed in Box 4.

Some oversize items have been flattened and stored in Plan Cabinet PC5, Drawer 1. These are indicated at the relevant point in the finding aid.

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ADMINISTRATIVE NOTE

The Aurukun Mission, situated on the west coast of the Cape York Peninsula, was established in 1904 by Moravian missionaries sponsored by the Presbyterian Church.

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In the early nineteen-seventies, over 200 children attended the school, which was staffed by mission personnel. The work in this collection was done in 1970-72 by 2nd and 3rd grade pupils in a combined grade taught by Annette Mitchell.

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SERIES DESCRIPTION
