Djarrangurr u ngullumbara dhelkunya djandak murrupa We meet together to return good health to Country and Spirit

Major Roles:

- 1. Prepare a Joint Management Plan for the Appointed lands, oversee its implementation through partnerships, and monitor compliance and performance.
- 2. Provide advice to the Minister and the Secretary of the DELWP in relation to the management of, and policies relating to, the Appointed lands.

Our Goals and Values



Vision: For the knowledge and culture of the Dja Dja Wurrung People to be recognised and incorporated into the management of the Appointed land.

Mission: To provide a platform for the development of the Jaara People and their lands.

Values:

- To fulfil Dja Dja Wurrung People's cultural obligations to look after our Country.
- To act with integrity and honesty to improve park management of the Appointed land.
- To act in good faith in the best interest of the Dja Dja Wurrung People and to build healthy partnerships with key stakeholders.
- To act with integrity and transparency in all relationships.
- To provide effective and transparent good governance.



- The Board takes its name from the Dja Dja Wurrung Country Plan.
- The Dja Dja Wurrung Clans Aboriginal Corporation (DDWCAC) nominates DDWCAC members to the Minister, who appoints to the Dhelkunya Dja land managemnt Board (DDLMB)
