Recent Cases (Australia)

Jango v Northern Territory of Australia (includes Summary) [2006] FCA 318 (31 March 2006)

Summary: The applicants seek a determination in respect of the Town of Yulara in the Northern Territory ('the Application Area'), which comprises an area of 104 square kilometres. The members of the compensation claim group are almost exclusively Yankunytjatjara or Pitjantjatjara people who, according to the applicants, held native title rights and interests in the Application Area and are entitled to compensation because their rights and interests were extinguished by certain 'compensation acts' that occurred over the period 1979 to 1992. The applicants say that the Northern Territory is liable under the NTA to pay compensation.

Riley v State of Queensland [2006] FCA 72 (Western Yalanji determination)

Turrbal People v State of Queensland (with Corrigendumdated 10 March 2006) [2006] FCA 187 (2 March 2006)

(1). Leave be given to amend the application in accordance with annexure 'DPB1' to the affidavit of Dale Patrick Brown sworn 1 February 2006 and filed herein, subject to the proviso that such amendment is not to include any area of land or waters that was not covered by the original application in May 1998.

(2) The proposed application stand as the amended application and the filing of the amended application be dispensed with.

(3). A further copy of the application, with the typographical errors identified and corrected, should be filed and served on the parties to the Part A proceedings.

Daniel v State of Western Australia [2006] FCA 271 (21 March 2006)

NATIVE TITLE – prescribed body corporate – Ngarluma prescribed body corporate – advent of appeals not make determination of prescribed body corporate inappropriate or inconvenient – one prescribed body corporate already in existence – appropriate for discretion to be exercised to make determination of the prescribed body corporate
