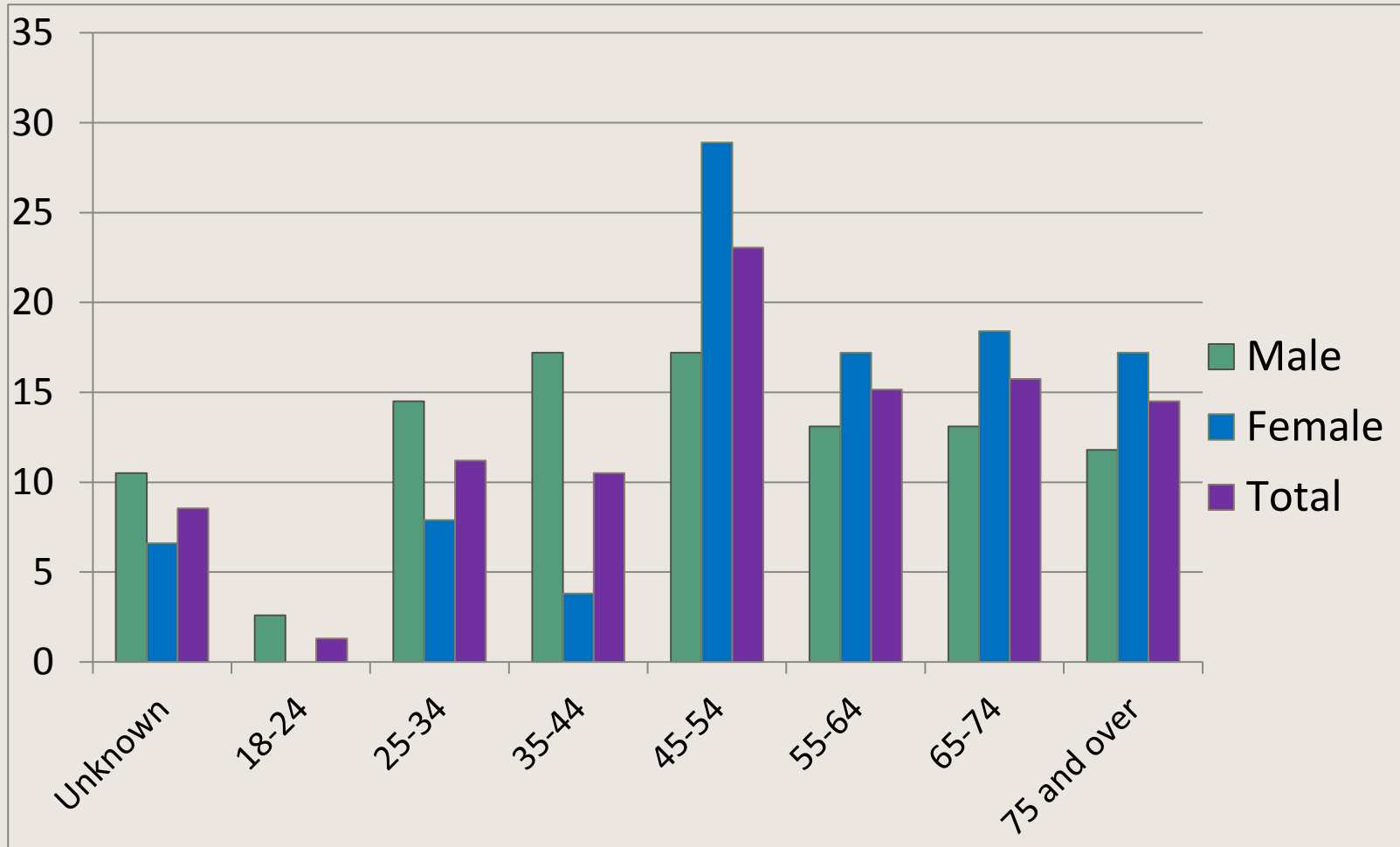

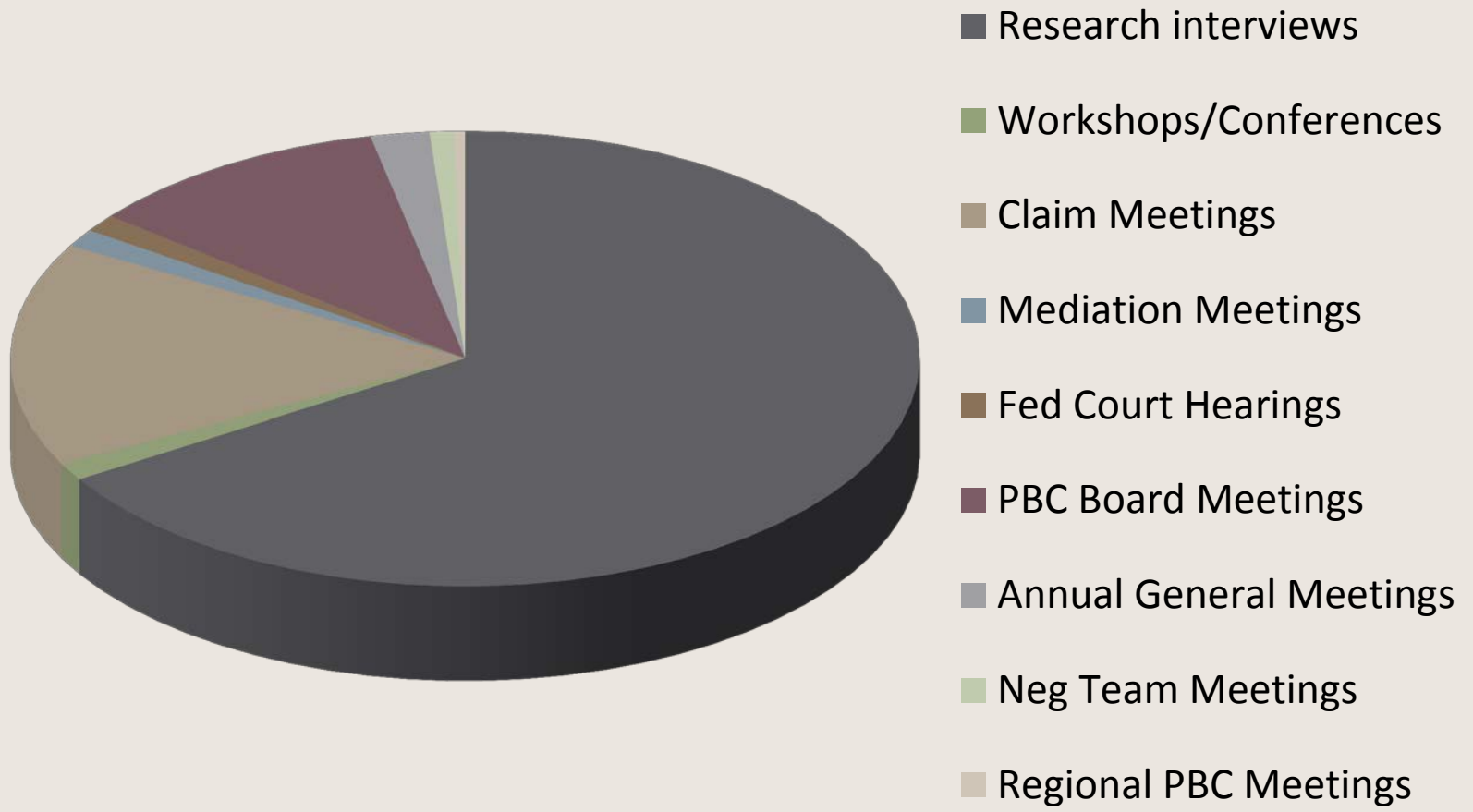
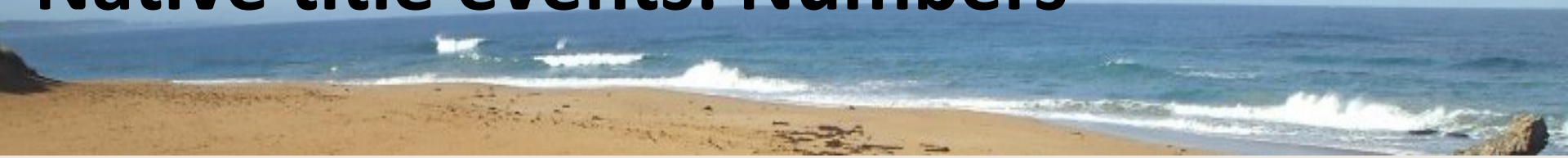
Eastern Maar: Gender and Age



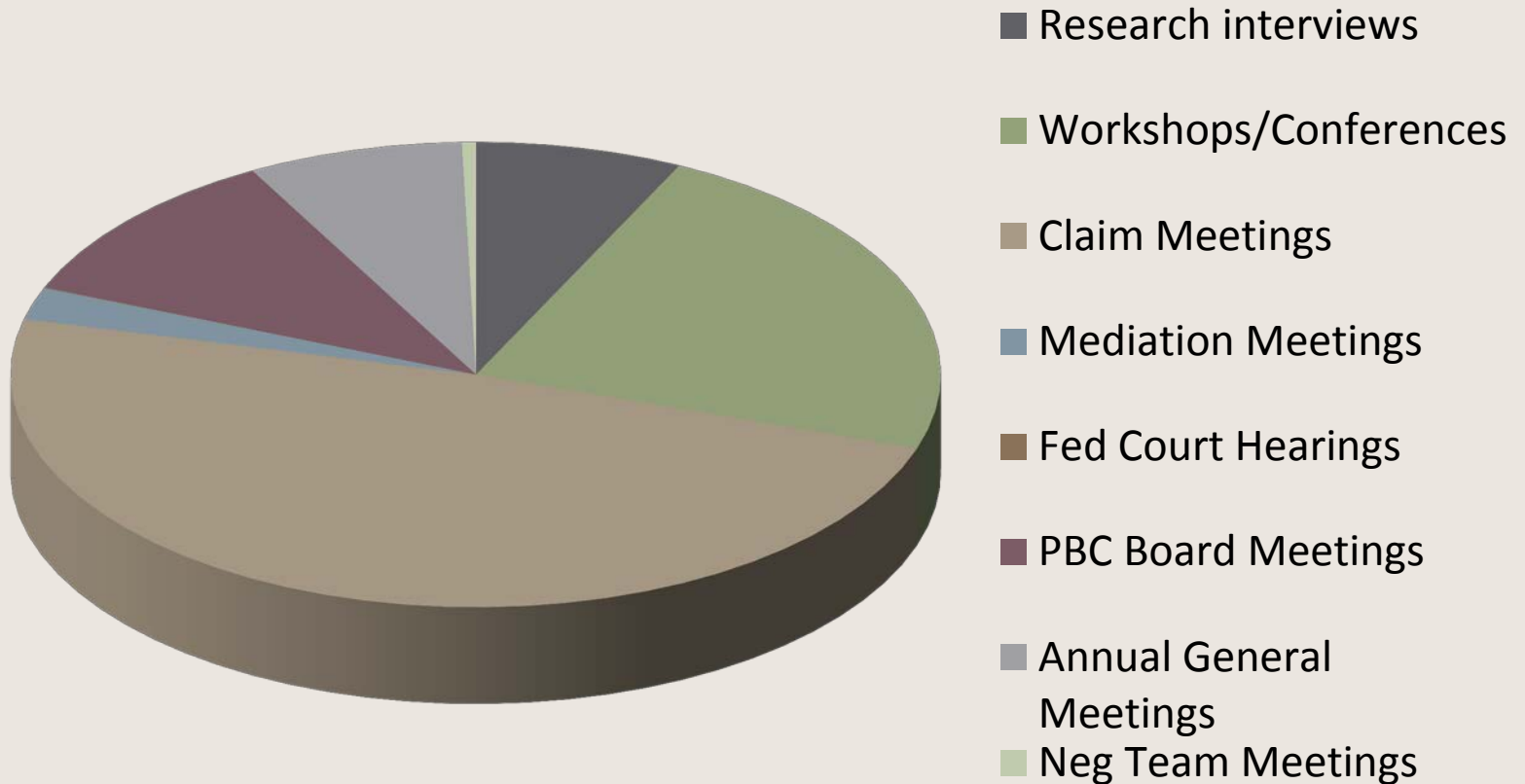

Expenditure of Time

Collectively Eastern Maar worked for 1,392 days on attending native title events

Individuals time varies depending on role

For example: Jeremy Clark minimum of 418 days of unpaid labour for native title claim work and establishing PBC

Cost of native title labour

NTSV spent a minimum of \$307,000 on hosting Eastern Maar native title events.

Eastern Maar community costs of event travel - \$33,000

Standard remuneration rates applied:

EMAC CEO min. \$160,000

Core group min. \$165,000

EM Claim group min. \$534, 528
