Who is Manungurra?

- “Manungurra” is a name chosen by the late Mr Archie Allen, one of the most senior Kunapa elders. It is a description that binds the Kunapa clan groups in a common and undivided way.
- The Kunapa land estate is situated north of Tennant Creek in a geographic area known as the Western Barkly Tablelands that overlaps the jurisdictions of both the Northern Land Council and the Central Land Council. The area of the estate includes areas of Banka Banka West Station, Brunchilly Station and Elroy Downs Station as well as the Warumungu Aboriginal Land Trust and the Kurnturlpara Aboriginal Land Trust.
- Manungurra was Incorporated in 2006 under ORIC.
