\*Lack of effective legislative protection for Indigenous matters.

\*Avoid negotiating interests through past-oriented, traditionalist constructions of cultural heritage.

\*Negotiated contractual arrangements – for protection of Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property (ICIP).

\*Multi-sited strategy designed to resist recycling and activating the 'colonial archive'.

\*The need for possession of resources for full engagement.
