- Section 37 Permit Applications for ceremonial harvest.

- Indigenous Fishing Strategy 2002.
- Traineeships.

Management:

Aboriginal Fishing Advisory Council.





QUEENSLAND

Legislative: YES

 Legislative defence provision for customary take.

<u>Programs/Initiatives</u>:

- Indigenous Fishing Strategy 2002.
- Indigenous Fishing Permit.

Management:

- Management recognition Indigenous as a separate sector.
- Nil licence or catch allocation.



VICTORIA

Legislative: Nil

Traditional Owner Recognition Permit.

Programs/Initiatives:

- Aboriginal Fishing Strategy.
- VIC Fisheries target 5% Aboriginal employment.

Management:

 Developing engagement practices in Fisheries Management.





TASMANIA

Legislative: YES

But limited to recreational fishing limits.

Programs/Initiatives:

Permits for customary or communal fishing.

Management: Nil





SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Legislative: Nil

Recognition via Ministerial exemptions only.

Programs/Initiatives:

- Indigenous Land Use Agreements.
- Developed model for Sea Ranger Program.
- Traineeships and Scholarships.

Management:

Minister may create Indigenous management plans.

- Indigenous recognised as a Sector
- Indigenous allocation in each fishery





WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Legislative: YES

Catch shares allocated to Customary sector (Lobster & Abalone)

Programs/Initiatives:

Customary Fishing Policy 2009.

Management:

Joint Management and Native Title Agreements.





NORTHERN TERRITORY

Legislative: YES

- Catch shares allocated to Customary sector (Spanish Mackerel).
- Customary harvest is exempt from Fisheries Act.
- Indigenous Sea Rangers with Compliance Powers (2017).
- Aboriginal Community Licences; small scale commercial.

Programs/Initiatives:

- Fisheries Research Indigenous Engagement Policy.
- Indigenous Development Strategy 2012-14.
- Indigenous Community Marine Ranger Program; funding and operational support undertaking coastal surveillance and fisheries research.
- Commercial fishing development, East Arnhem Land.
- Indigenous Maritime Training Program, Nhulunbuy.
- Fisheries Indigenous Development Unit within the Department.
- Apprenticeships.
- Cadetships.
- Current NT Fisheries Indigenous employment rate is 22%.

Management:

- Indigenous Resource Management Committees.
- Aboriginal representation in fishery management committees.
- Aboriginal representation on NTFRAB.





AUSTRALIAN FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

Legislative: YES

- Torres Strait Fisheries Act.
- Right to take fish for commercial or trade.

<u>Programs/Initiatives</u>:

- Torres Strait Treaty 1985.
- Licence allocation; 100% fin fished owned by Torres Strait communities.
- Sea Ranger Program assistance

Management:

- Protection Zone Joint Authority; Australia and PNG.
- Indigenous recognised as a Sector.
